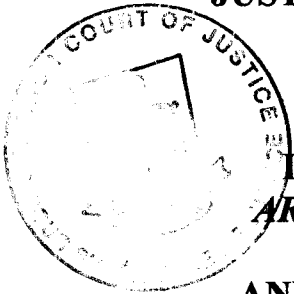

ORDER

4. sealing the Monitor's Supplemental Report dated March 6, 2007 (the "Supplemental Report") pending further order of this Honourable Court; and


5. such further and other relief as this Honourable Court may deem just;

1. THIS COURT ORDERS that the time for service of the Notice of Motion and the Second Report be and is hereby abridged so that this Motion is properly returnable today and that service of such motion material on interested parties not served be and is hereby dispensed with.

2. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Stay of Proceedings be and is hereby extended to and including April 8, 2007.
3. THIS COURT ORDERS that the Supplemental Record filed with the Commercial List Court Office shall be treated as confidential, shall be sealed and shall not form part of the public record until further order of this Honourable Court.
4. THIS COURT ORDERS that the activities of the Monitor set out in the Second Report, be and are hereby approved.
