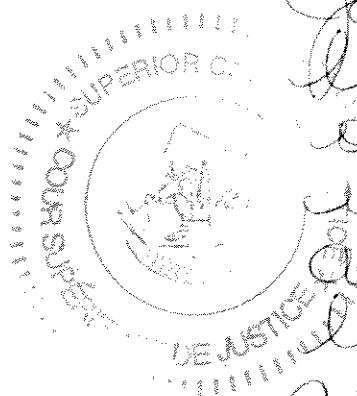


Jan. 27/08.



Notwithstanding my order of Jan 25/08, the Justice has not been able to secure possession of the Ledco premises, as it is obliged to do. The premises are being occupied, it appears by employees of Ledco who are understandably aggrieved by their loss of employment & the manner in which they have been treated by Ledco. An application to the OLRB has been commenced respecting the lockout of the employees among other issues.

My letter in his submissions outlined for the Court the complaints of the employees. I understand these complaints but their resolution is for another day. It must be observed that the occupation of the premises in contravention of an order of this Court is not the way to find a solution.

The rule of law must prevail.

I make the following order:

1. Service of my order + warrant dated January 25/08 on the CAW National is effective today January 27/08
2. The Waterloo Regional police services shall attend at the Dedco premises this afternoon & serve the occupants a photocopy of my order + warrant dated January 25/08 together with a copy of this order.
3. The Waterloo Regional police services are permitted to obtain & disclose to the trustee the names of those persons served & the circumstances of service.
4. The trustee may maintain on the site private security guards.
5. Possession of the Dedco property must be delivered to the trustee by no later

than 4 pm. today
Sunday January 27/08.

I make no order regarding
proceedings for contempt at
this time.
