



2. **THIS COURT ORDERS AND DIRECTS** that Dofasco shall immediately provide to the Applicant all product requested by the Applicant that has as of the date hereof been manufactured for the Applicant provided that the Applicant shall pay in full for any such product requested prior to the product being loaded onto the Applicant's carrier.

3. **THIS COURT ORDERS** that this Order and any actions of the parties taken in complying with this Order shall be without prejudice to the rights and positions of either the Applicant or Dofasco in respect of the obligation of Dofasco, if any, to continue supplying product to the Applicant pursuant to the relationship between the parties and the terms of the Initial Order of this Court made September 15, 2009 and the Recognition Order of this Court made September 15, 2009.
