

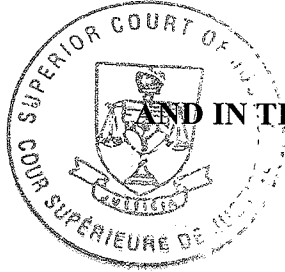

**BANKRUPTCY ORDER**

ON the Application of HSBC Bank Canada, a creditor, of the City of Toronto, in the Province of  
Ontario, filed the 14<sup>th</sup> day of August, 2008,

HAVING HEARD the submissions of counsel for HSBC Bank Canada and having  
read the affidavit of verification and the consent of the proposed trustee, Deloitte & Touche Inc.,

AND it appearing to the court that the following act of bankruptcy has been  
committed:

- (a) the debtor has ceased to meet its liabilities generally as they become due and has  
failed to pay the Applicant and other creditors within the six months next preceding  
the petition.


1. THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that Automated Fluid Power and Control Inc.,  
5540 Mainway Drive, in the Town of Burlington in the Province of Ontario, be adjudged bankrupt  
by virtue of a bankruptcy order hereby made on this date.

2. THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that Deloitte & Touche Inc. of the City of  
Toronto, in the Province of Ontario be appointed as trustee of the estate of the bankrupt.

3. THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that the trustee shall give security in cash or by  
bond in accordance with subsection 16(1) of the *Bankruptcy and Insolvency Act*.

4. THE COURT HEREBY ORDERS that the costs of the Applicant shall be paid out of the estate of the bankrupt upon taxation of the estate.
