### Wintegra tops Deloitte Brightman Almagor Fast 50

Wintegra is the winner of 2006 Fast 50, held by accounting and consulting firm Deloitte Brightman Almagor. Wintegra, which develops semiconductors for IP networks, won the award for the fastest-growing technology company in Israel, after posting sales growth of 22,422% between 2001 and 2005.

This is the seventh year that the competition has been held in Israel, as part of the Fast 500 competition held by Deloitte in the EMEA region.

#### The Winners

The 2006 Technology Fast 50 companies have shown revenue growth rates with an average of 1,610% compared to the 746% shown by the 2005 Fast 50 companies and an average of 1,049% shown by the 2004 Fast 50 companies. The top 10 companies grew an average of 6,413%, a significant increase compared to last year's top 10 companies that averaged a growth percentage of 2,894%. Revenues for the 2006 program's top company, the semiconductors company Wintegra, grew 22,422% between the years 2001 and 2005 compared to growth of 8,221% by Actimize last year.

"Achieving sustained revenue growth over five years is a tremendous accomplishment for a technology company operating in a competitive world", said Asher Mechlovich, partner in charge of the Deloitte Brightman Almagor Israel Technology Fast 50 Program." Wintegra deserves a lot of credit for its remarkable growth, and we commend them for it."

#### Special Acknowledgements

Outstanding results shown by msystem - Among the 2006 Fast 50 winners there is one company that crosses the half billion dollars revenue, with 1,276% percentage growth. This percentage growth is particularly impressive, taking into consideration the large size of msystems. The company was acquired in July 2006 by SanDisk, for more than 1.5 billion dollars.

Identify acquisition - Identify, who has been among the Fast 50 winners during the past two years, has been acquired by BMC Software Inc, an IT Business Management Company, on March 2006 for \$150 million.
