# 2008 Orange County Technology Fast 50

The Orange County Technology Fast 50 program annually recognizes the 50 fastest-growing technology, media and life sciences companies in the areas of:

- Software
- Biotechnology and Pharmaceutical
- Internet
- Communications and Networking
- Scientific and Technical Instrumentation
- Semiconductors
- Medical Equipment
- Media and Entertainment
- Computers and Peripherals

The Orange County program recognizes companies based on percentage revenue growth over five years (2003 to 2007). Operating revenues must be at least \$50,000 for 2003 and at least \$5,000,000 for 2007.

In addition, companies must own proprietary intellectual property or proprietary technology that contributes to a significant portion of their revenues and/or devotes a significant portion of operating revenue to research and development of technology.

Companies may be either public or private, must be in business for at least five years and be headquartered within Orange County.
