

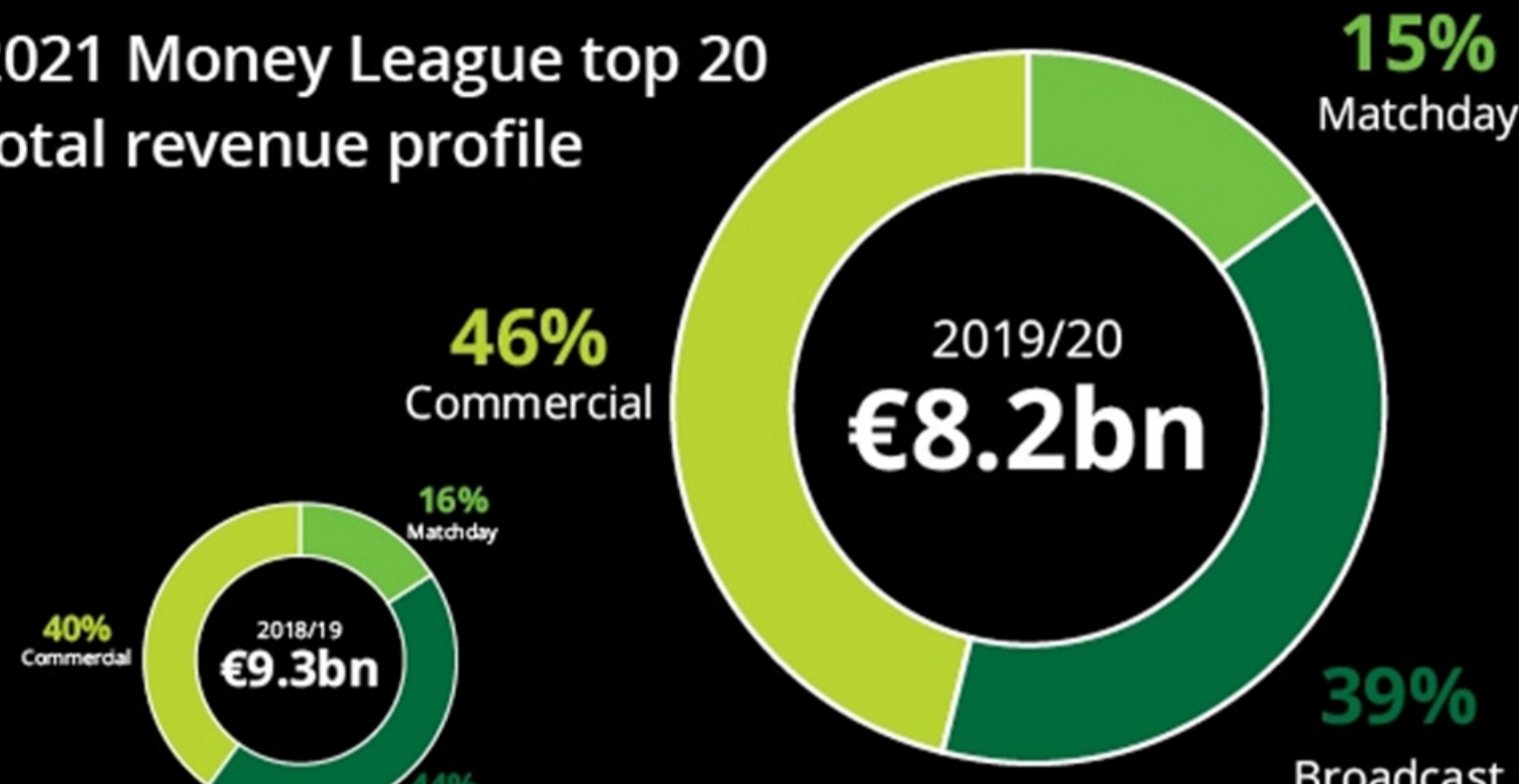

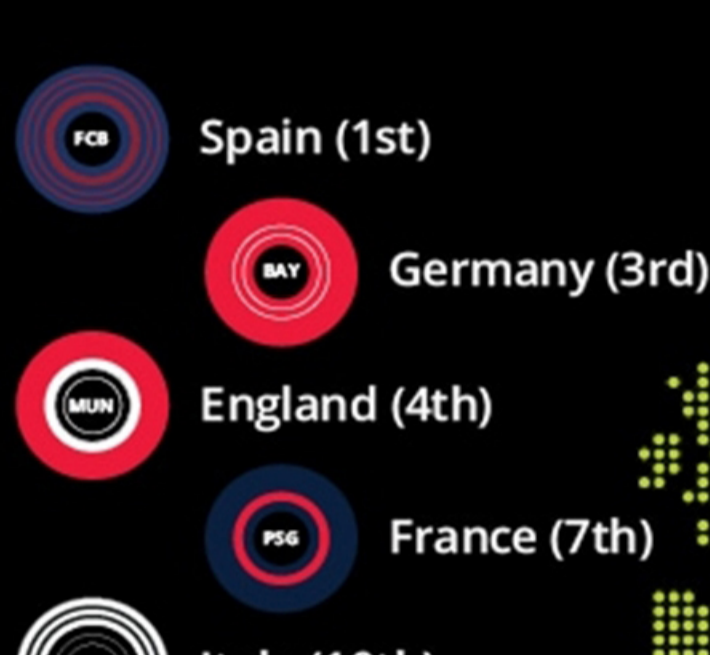
2021 Money League top 20 clubs



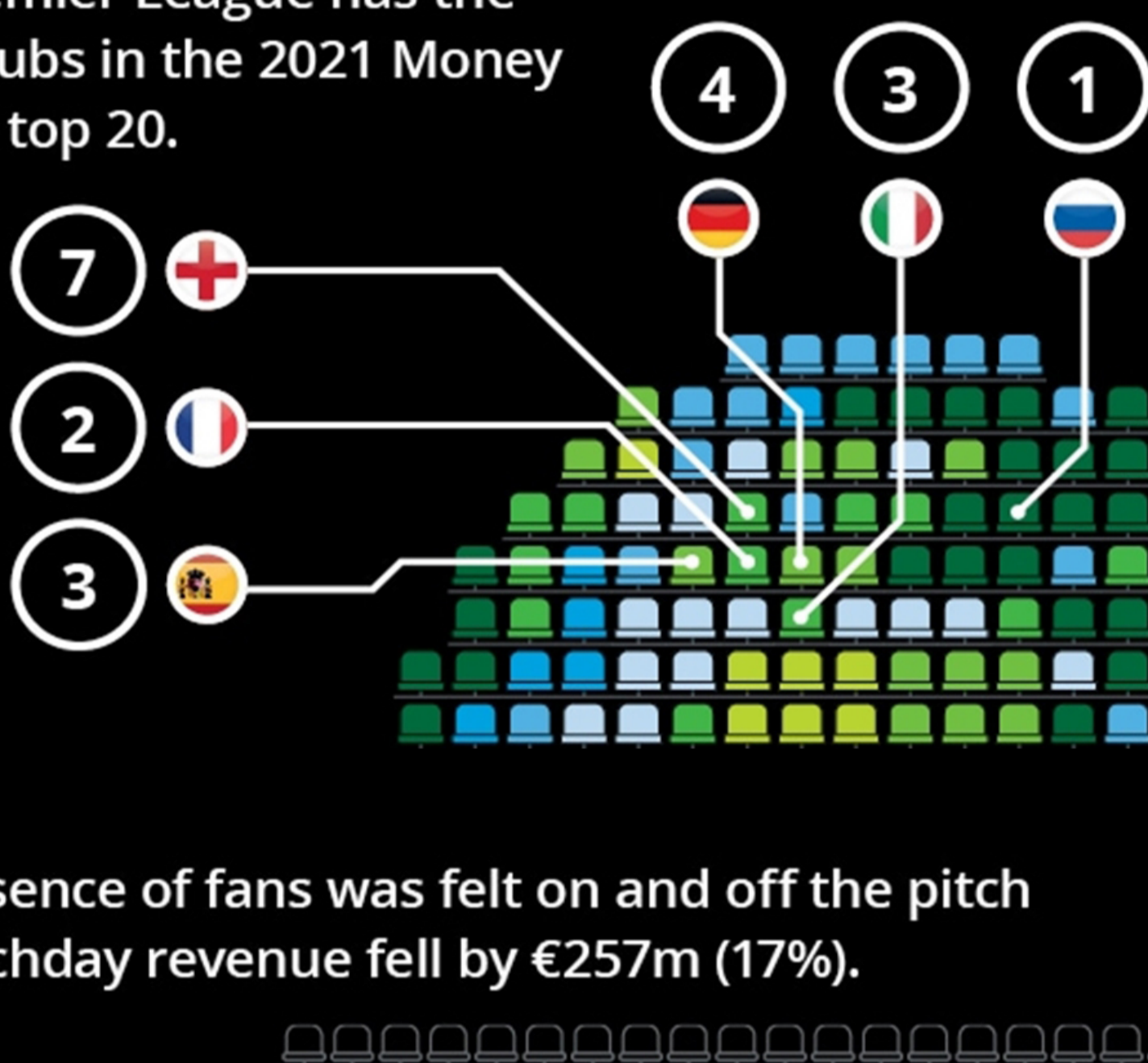
2021 Money League top 20 total revenue profile



FC Barcelona, Bayern Munich, Manchester United, Paris Saint-Germain and Juventus were the highest revenue generating clubs in each of the 'big five' leagues.



The Premier League has the most clubs in the 2021 Money League top 20.



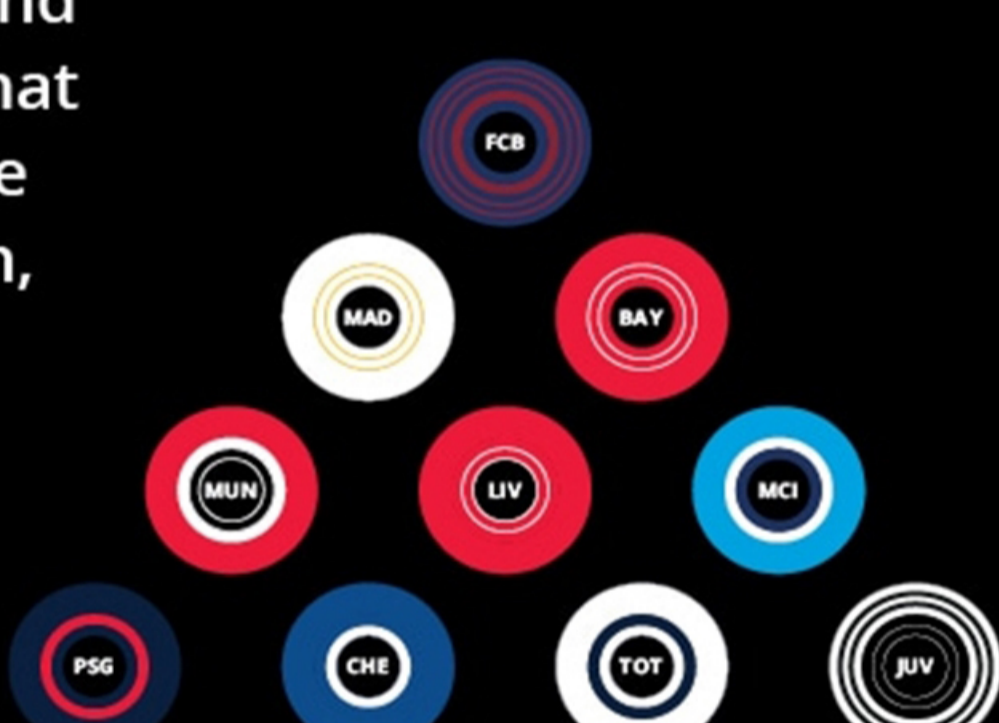
The absence of fans was felt on and off the pitch as matchday revenue fell by €257m (17%).



Broadcast rights payment deferrals hit Money League clubs' revenues hard, with broadcast revenues falling by €937m (23%).



Whilst the world around us changed in 2020, that wasn't the case for the Money League top ten, which remained the same as in last year's Money League.

of Money League clubs have a women's football team.



Average revenue of the top 20 Money League clubs was €409m in 2019/20, a 12% decrease on the prior year.



Money League clubs will have missed out on over €2 billion of revenue by the end of the 2020/21 season as a result of the pandemic.
