Extended deadline for the submission of 2019 personal income tax returns and for the payment of tax

We would like to inform you that in accordance with a [Decree](#) issued on 20 October 2020, the following deadlines are extended to **30 November 2020**:

- **Electronic submission** of the **2019** personal income tax return by **employees** and **pensioners** (TD1 - Employee) whose gross income exceeds €19.500, and for the **payment** of the final tax due, and
- **Electronic submission** of the **2019** personal income tax return by **self-employed** individuals (TD1 – Self-employed) with turnover that does not exceed the amount of €70.000 and who do not have obligation to prepare audited financial statements and for the **payment** of the relevant tax due.
