




Accelerating developer experience

- 1 Clarify your north star**

- 2 Place your bets**
Identify target developer personas, challenges, and needs to prioritize investments for delightful experiences.
- 3 Articulate value**
Leverage data-driven methods and clearly-defined KPIs to help quantify tangible and intangible benefits and to measure progress.
- 4 Re-energize culture and community**
Intentionally cultivate a diverse and inclusive developer culture to accelerate productivity and improve satisfaction.
- 5 Anticipate and design for regulation**
Adopt a proactive compliance mindset to prevent unintended risk, cost, delay, and frustration.
- 6 Think about convergence**
Converge internal and external DevEx strategies, where possible, to leverage both developer communities for competitive advantage.
