I. Vendim i Këshillit te Ministrave nr. 693, datë 29.10.2019 "Për disa shtesa dhe ndryshime ne vendimin nr. 408, datë 13.05.2015 të Këshillit të Ministrave, "Për miratimin e rregullores së zhvillimit te territorit", te ndryshuar.

Këshilli i Ministrave ka miratuar vendimin nr. 693, datë 29.10.2019 "Për disa shtesa dhe ndryshime në vendimin nr. 408, datë 13.5.2015 të Këshillit te Ministrave, "Për miratimin e rregullores se zhvillimit te territorit", te ndryshuar". Vendimi është botuar në Fletoren Zyrtare nr. 145, datë 29.10.2019 dhe ka hyrë në fuqi pas botimit.

Me qëllim thjeshtëzimin dhe sqarimin e mëtejshëm te procedurës se dhënies se lejeve te ndërtimit, vendimi parashikon disa shtesa dhe ndryshime te rregullores se zhvillimit te territorit.

Midis te tjerave, ky vendim shtrin kompetencat e Këshillit Kombëtar te Territorit edhe mbi miratimin e lejeve te ndërtimit për objektet si dhe veprat e infrastrukturës brenda zonës se brezit bregdetar.

Gjithashtu, vendimi zgjat afatin e procedurës se përshpejtuar nga 10 dite ne 20 dite pune, ndërsa zvogëlon afatet dhe lehtëson procedurën e përshpejtuar ne raste aplikimi për leje ndërtimi për riparime dhe restaurime të objekteve te dëmtuara si pasoje e fatkeqësive natyrore dhe emergjencave civile.

Se fundmi, vendimi parashikon te gjitha dokumentet e nevojshme qe duhet te paraqesë aplikanti për tu pajisur me certifikatë përdorimi. I. Decision of Council of Ministers no. 693, dated 29.10.2019 "On some additions and amendments to the decision no. 408, dated on 13.05.2015 of the Council of Ministers "On the approval of the regulation on the development of the territory", as amended.

The Council of Ministers has adopted the decision no. 693, dated 29.10.2019 "On some additions and amendments to the decision no. 408, dated on 13.05.2015 of the Council of Ministers "On the approval of the regulation on the development of the territory". The decision has been published with the Official Gazette no. 145, dated on 29.10.2019, entered into force after its publication.

With the aim of simplifying and further clarifying the construction permit procedure, the decision provides for some additions and amendments to the regulation on territory development.

Among others, the decision extends the scope of the competencies of the National Council of Territory also to the approval of the construction permit for the objects or infrastructure works within the coastal area.

Moreover, the decision extends the terms of the accelerated procedure from 10 days to 20 working days, while reduces the terms and ease such procedure in case of applications for construction permit for reparations and restorations of the damaged objects as a result of natural disasters and civil emergencies.

Finally yet importantly, the decision lists all the necessary documents that the applicant should provide in order to be granted with a usage permit.
