

Work under this contract shall be performed in accordance with the Performance Work Statement (PWS) and Attachment No. 1 Contract Data Requirements List (CDRL).

PSS1 - PERFORMANCE-BASED STATEMENT OF OBJECTIVES

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this Statement of Objectives (SOO) is to provide a framework around which the respondents shall build a Performance Work Statement (PWS) to provide Program Support Services to the Navy Enterprise Resources Planning (ERP) Program Management Office. Navy ERP is an integrated mission support system that modernizes and standardizes Navy support operations, provides unprecedented visibility across the enterprise, and increases management effectiveness and efficiency. Using off-the-shelf capabilities within the commercial product SAP, Navy ERP is transforming how the service manages its people, money, programs, equipment, supplies, and maintenance. The SAP R/3 and Enterprise Central Component (ECC) 5.0 commercial software suite in use by the program is the Public Sector Industry Solution certified by the U.S. Government Joint Financial Management Improvement Program (JFMIP).

A PWS submitted in response to this SOO shall address:

- § Transition and implementation of Release 1.0 to Navy Commands in accordance with the Navy ERP Deployment Schedule
- § Transition and implementation of Release 1.1 to Navy Commands in accordance with the Navy ERP Deployment Schedule beginning FY 2010.
- § Sustainment of Release 1.0 currently in production
- § Integration of Release 1.1 into the Release 1.0 baseline and sustainment of the integrated baseline including consolidated Help Desk Support
- § Application of upgrades to SAP, Oracle, middleware and supporting software and ensure integrity of configured and custom functionality

2.0 BACKGROUND and SCOPE

Navy ERP is designated as an Acquisition Category I (ACAT I), Major Automated Information System (MAIS) within the Department of Defense (DoD). In September 2007 the program achieved acquisition Milestone C and is now in the deployment phase of software Release 1.0. Release 1.0 provides Navy Echelon II and Echelon III commands with a full suite of automated tools to perform their business functions. Release 1.0 functionality falls into 5 major categories:

Release 1.0 is currently operational at the Naval Air Systems Command (NAVAIR) supporting close to 15,000 users. Initial Operating Capability (IOC) was achieved in May 2008. The next major implementation of Release 1.0 will be to the Naval Supply Systems Command (NAVSUP) in October of 2008 and will add 10,000 users, bringing the total users to approximately 25,000. Implementation of Release 1.0 at the Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR) will occur in October 2009 and will add approximately 9,200 users. Implementation of Release 1.0 at the Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) will occur in October 2010 for the General Fund and October 2011 for the Working Capital Fund and will add approximately 26,000 users.

A second major release of software, version 1.1 (Supply Chain Management) is currently in development under a separate SEAPORT order, N00178-05-D-4364 (EH02). Release 1.1 provides Wholesale and Retail Supply functionality for Navy Inventory Control Points (ICPs) and Fleet and Industrial Supply Centers (FISCs). The initial deployment of Release 1.1 to NAVICP in February 2010 will be implemented under the SEAPORT order mentioned above. Task order option years include subsequent deployments. However, the government may choose not to exercise those options in favor of integrating the deployment activities in this award. Releases 1.0 and 1.1 will become an integrated single instance solution and will be rolled out as such beginning in FY10 to components of NAVSUP and in FY11 to Naval Sea Systems Command (NAVSEA) components. The program is expected to achieve Full Operational Capability (FOC) at the end of fiscal year 2013. At FOC, Navy ERP will be deployed to 62,500 users at 49 shore sites around the world.

SECTION H SPECIAL CONTRACT REQUIREMENTS

H-1 SEGREGATION OF COSTS (DEC 2003) (5252.232-9206)

- (a) The Contractor agrees to segregate costs incurred under this task order at the lowest level of performance, either task or subtask, rather than on a total task order basis, and to submit invoices reflecting costs incurred at that level. Invoices shall contain summaries of work charged during the period covered, as well as overall cumulative summaries by labor category for all work invoiced to date, by line item, task or subtask.
- (b) Where multiple lines of accounting are present, the ACRN preceding the accounting citation will be found in attached Financial Accounting Data (FAD) sheet. Payment of Contractor invoices shall be accomplished only by charging the ACRN that corresponds to the work invoiced.
- (c) Except when payment requests are submitted electronically as specified in the clause at DFARS 252.232-7003, Electronic Submission of Payment Requests, one copy of each invoice or voucher will be provided, at the time of submission to DCAA, to the Task Order Manager.

H-2 DATA RIGHTS

The Data Rights clause in the basic contract is invoked for this task order.

H-3 CONTRACTOR IDENTIFICATION (DEC 1999) (SPAWAR H-355)

- (a) Contractor employees must be clearly identifiable while on Government property by wearing appropriate badges.

Confidential business information may include technical data as that term is defined in DFARS §§ 252.227-7013(a)(14), 252.227-7015(a)(4), and 252.227-7018(a)(19). It may also include computer software as that term is defined in DFARS §§ 252.227-7014(a)(4) and 252.227-7018(a)(4).

(b) The Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command (SPAWAR) may release to individuals employed by SPAWAR support contractors and their subcontractors confidential business information

submitted by the contractor or its subcontractors pursuant to the provisions of this contract. Business information that would ordinarily be entitled to confidential treatment may be included in the information released to these individuals. Accordingly, by submission of a proposal or execution of this contract, the offeror or contractor and its subcontractors consent to a limited release of its confidential business information.

- (c) Circumstances where SPAWAR may release the contractor's or subcontractors' confidential business information include the following:
- (1) To other SPAWAR contractors and subcontractors, and their employees tasked with assisting SPAWAR in handling and processing information and documents in the administration of SPAWAR contracts, such as file room management and contract closeout.
- (2) To SPAWAR contractors and subcontractors, and their employees tasked with assisting SPAWAR in accounting support services, including access to cost-reimbursement vouchers.

- (4) Contractors and their subcontractors having access to confidential business information have agreed under their contract or a separate corporate non-disclosure agreement to provide the same level of protection to confidential business information that would be provided by SPAWAR employees, and
- (5) SPAWAR contractors and their subcontractors performing the tasks described in paragraphs (c)(1), (c)(2) or (c)(3) have agreed under their contract or a separate non-disclosure agreement to not use confidential business information for any purpose other than performing the tasks described in paragraphs (c)(1), (c)(2) and (c)(3).
- (e) SPAWAR's responsibilities under the Freedom of Information Act are not affected by this clause.
- (f) If SPAWAR satisfies the conditions listed in paragraph (d), the contractor and its subcontractors agree to indemnify and hold harmless the Government, its agents, and employees from every claim or liability, including attorneys fees, court costs, and expenses, arising out of, or in any way related to, the misuse or unauthorized modification, reproduction, release, display, or disclosure of confidential business information provided by the contractor to the Government.
- (g) The contractor agrees to include, and require inclusion of, this clause in all subcontracts at any tier that requires the furnishing of confidential business information.

- (b) The Contractor hereby agrees that it will not divulge any Planning, Programming and Budgeting System (PPBS) data made available to it under this contract to any individual (including other members of the contractor's organization), company or Government representative, unless specific written authorization is received from the Contracting Officer. The Contractor also agrees that it will promptly notify the Contracting Officer of any attempt by any individual (including other members of the contractor's organization), company or Government representative to gain access to such PPBS data. Such notification shall include the name and organization, if available, of the individual (including other member's of the contractor's organization), company or Government representative.

- (e) In the event the Contractor, or any of its employees, agents, or subcontractors (or their employees, agents or subcontractors), fail to comply with the provisions of this clause, such noncompliance shall be deemed a material breach of the contract for which the Government reserves the right to avail itself of any or all of the following remedies:
- (1) Terminate the contract for default in accordance with FAR § 52.249-6 ("Termination (Cost-Reimbursement)")(SEP 1996) or FAR § 52.249-8 ("Default (Fixed-Price Supply and Service")
- (2) Include a discussion of such failure to comply with this clause in any evaluation by the Government of the Contractor's performance of this contract created pursuant to FAR 42.15.
- (3) resort to such other rights and remedies as provided for under this contract and under Federal law.

Waiver of such rights by the Government for noncompliance shall not be construed as waiver for any successive noncompliance.

(f) Any subcontractor who is granted access to PPBS data shall be subject to the restrictions stated in subparagraphs (a) through (e) above. The Contractor shall notify the subcontractor that it is so subject. The Organizational Conflict of Interest clause in the contractor's basic SeaPort IDIQ contract is incorporated in this task order by reference.

H-8 5252.237-9106 SUBSTITUTION OF PERSONNEL (SEP 1990)

- (a) The Contractor agrees that a partial basis for award of this contract is the list of key personnel proposed. Accordingly, the Contractor agrees to assign to this contract those key persons whose resumes were submitted with the proposal necessary to fulfill the requirements of the contract. No substitution shall be made without prior notification to and concurrence of the Contracting Officer in accordance with this requirement.
- (b) All proposed substitutes shall have qualifications equal to or higher than the qualifications of the person to be replaced. The Contracting Officer shall be notified in writing of any proposed substitution at least forty-five (45) days, or ninety (90) days if a security clearance is to be obtained, in advance of the proposed substitution. Such notification shall include: (1) an explanation of the circumstances necessitating the substitution; (2) a complete resume of the proposed substitute; and (3) any other information requested by the Contracting Officer to enable him/her to judge whether or not the Contractor is maintaining the same high quality of personnel that provided the partial basis for award.
