
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


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Tariffs on imports of Canadian-origin aluminum

On 6 August 2020, US President Trump signed a presidential proclamation reinstating supplemental tariffs on certain aluminum products from Canada, effective as from 16 August 2020. The 10% tariffs will be levied on non-alloyed unwrought aluminum of Canadian origin.

In response to the US tariff announcement of 6 August, Canada is proposing proportionate countermeasures consisting of surtaxes to be imposed on imports of certain aluminum and aluminum-containing products that are eligible to be marked as US origin products.

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
