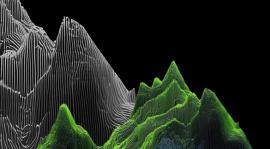
Australian banks have a particular strength in supporting customers through efficient digital onboarding and day to day banking in digital channels, with a breadth of self-service capabilities available.
