## IN ATTENDANCE

Refer to the attached attendance registers.

### **CHAIRPERSON**

Vaughan Strawbridge, Joint and Several Liquidator of the Companies, opened the meeting at 11:04 AM and advised that he would act as the Chairperson (**Chairperson**) of the meeting in accordance with Regulation 5.6.17(1) of the Corporations Regulations.

The Chairperson advised that Mr David Lombe, the other Joint and Several Liquidator of the Companies, was not in attendance and sent his apologies.

The Chairperson advised that this was a Meeting of Creditors for Animal Supplies (Wholesale) Pty Ltd (In Liquidation), AS Consolidated Pty Limited (In Liquidation), Australian Supply and Distribution Solutions Pty Ltd (In Liquidation) and ACN 094 221 913 Pty Ltd (formerly Pet Brands Connect Pty Ltd) (In Liquidation), which he would refer to collectively as "the Companies" or the "Animal Supplies Group" for the remainder of the meeting.

The Chairperson noted the attendance of Andrew Whittingham and Kevin Thay who assist with the day-to-day management of the liquidation.

The Chairperson confirmed that all those present at the meeting had signed the attendance register and where appropriate, had provided proxy forms. For those attending via teleconference, the Chairperson noted he would sign the attendance register on their behalf. There were no objections.

## **PURPOSE OF MEETING**

The Chairperson advised the meeting was convened for the following purposes:

- 1. To provide an update to creditors in relation to the liquidation of the respective companies;
- 2. To consider the actions required to be carried out to completion of the winding up and an estimate of the time required;
- 3. To consider, and if thought fit, approve the Liquidators' current professional fees and disbursements for PBC and ASDS
- 4. To consider, and if thought fit, approve the Liquidators' future professional fees and disbursements for PBC and ASDS
- 5. To consider any other matters that may be lawfully brought forward.

## TABLING OF DOCUMENTS

The Chairperson tabled the following documents:

- 1. Notice of Meeting of Creditors dated 3 May 2017;
- 2. Report to Creditors dated 3 May 2017;
- 3. Remuneration Report dated 26 April 2017;
- 4. Receipts and Payments Summary for ASW, ASDS and PBC for period 14 April 2016 31 March 2017; and
- 5. The Statement in Writing of Posting of Notice of Meeting (Form 530) dated 5 May 2017 and executed by Ms. Maria De Guzman of Kwik Kopy Printing, 28-30 Market Street, Sydney NSW 2000.

As there were no objections, the Chairperson took the tabled documents as being read.

## NOTICE OF MEETING

The Chairperson advised that the meeting has been convened in accordance with the Notice of Meeting dated 3 May 2017, which has been advertised in the Australian Securities & Investments Commission (ASIC) Insolvency Notices website (<a href="https://insolvencynotices.asic.gov.au">https://insolvencynotices.asic.gov.au</a>).

## **DECLARATION OF CONVENIENCE**

The declaration advised that he had not received any objections that the time and place was not convenient for this meeting. Therefore pursuant to Corporations Regulation 5.6.14, the Chairperson declared the meeting was being held at a time and place most convenient for the majority of persons entitled to receive notice of the meeting, and that there were also creditors attending via teleconference.

## **QUORUM**

The Chairperson declared in accordance with Regulation 5.6.16 of the Corporations Regulations that a quorum was present for each of the entities for the meeting.

The Chairperson noted the meetings were being held concurrently. No creditors objected to the meetings being held concurrently.

The Chairperson also advised that he would run through resolutions separately for the creditors of each respective entity, where applicable.

## OUTLINE OF THE REPORT TO CREDITORS DATED 3 MAY 2017

The Chairperson noted the recent Report to Creditors dated 3 May 2017 was to provide an update to creditors in relation to the liquidation of the respective companies, which included the following matters:

- Investigations undertaken by the Liquidators;
- The estimated returns to each class of creditor in each company;
- The matters which remain outstanding in each liquidation;
- Details of current and prospective remuneration of the Liquidators (approval of the remuneration will be sought at this meeting); and
- The estimated timeframe for completion of the respective liquidations.

# **ESTIMATED RETURN TO CREDITORS**

The Chairperson referred to page six of the Report to Creditors dated 3 May 2017, and outlined the estimated distributions paid or to be paid for each class of creditors in the four entities, as outlined in the below table:

The Chairperson also noted for the purpose of comparison, that the estimated return to unsecured creditors of ASW and PBC provided in the 439A Report were 4 cents and 30-39 cents respectively.

## **INVESTIGATIONS**

The Chairperson advised that reports pursuant to Section 533(1) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) (**the Act**) had been lodged with ASIC.

The Chairperson advised that the Liquidators were pursuing the recovery of several unfair preference payments to creditors under Section 588FA of the Act, and noted some of the claims had been settled, whilst the majority of these claims would be finalised in the coming months.

The Chairperson advised the Liquidators had finalised their assessment of the potential insolvent trading claim against the directors. As detailed in the Report, there were three likely scenarios in respect to the potential claim.

The Chairperson noted that Scenario 1 was not an option, and was provided in the Report merely for comparison purposes.

The Chairperson advised Scenario 3 was the scenario proposed by the Liquidators as it would mean they do not need to incur costs of pursuing a formal action against the directors and a dividend would be paid to priority and unsecured creditors by the end of 2017.

The Chairperson noted that there were no creditors in favour of Scenario 2.

## RETURN TO CREDITORS TO DATE

The Chairperson advised the Liquidators had distributed funds to the ATO in satisfaction of the pre-appointment Superannuation Guarantee Charge of the respective employing entities, being ASW, ASDS and PBC.

Since the issue of the Report, the Chairperson advised that the Liquidators had further made full and final priority distributions in PBC (to FEG and three employees with outstanding unpaid bonuses) and ASW (to FEG only).

## **OUESTIONS FROM ATTENDEES**

The Chairperson opened the meeting to any questions from creditors.

The following questions were raised during the meeting from attendees, with the following responses provided by the Chairperson:

Q: Is there a potential for further preference recoveries, other than the figures you have provided in the Report?

A: No, all potential unfair preference recoveries that have been identified are provided in the Report.

Q: Did the directors put money into the business prior to the appointment of Administrators? A: Yes, a significant amount was injected into the business by the directors. However this does not preclude a claim of insolvent trading against the directors. The two matters are to be looked at separately.

Q: What actions were taken by the directors following to the independent advice that was provided to them by Grant Thornton?

A: They appointed us as Voluntary Administrators.

Q: How long from the moment the directors realised that the Companies were insolvent, did they begin negotiations with Deloitte?

A: Less than 24 hours, the afternoon prior to the appointment of Administrators.

Q: I had goods delivered ten minutes prior to the appointment of Administrators. On this fact, the directors should have realised that they were not insolvent and not have accepted the goods.

A: That is a fair point.

At this point in the meeting, several creditors raised questions regarding the potential insolvent trading claim against the directors. These questions and answers remain commercially sensitive in nature, and have not been published in the minutes.

Q: Is there a Committee of Inspection?

A: Yes. Only for ASW

### **VOTING**

The Chairperson advised all motions are to be resolved on the voices, unless a poll is demanded (Regulation 5.6.19 and 5.6.20).

The Chairperson asked that when a motion is called that those in favour of the motion call 'aye and those against 'nay'.

The Chairperson advised there were options for creditors to demand a poll. A poll could be demanded before or on the declaration of a result on the voices by:

- (a) The Chairperson;
- (b) At least two persons present in person, by proxy or by attorney and entitled to vote at the meeting; or
- (c) A person present in person, by proxy or by attorney and representing not less than 10% of the total voting rights of all creditors entitled to vote at the meeting.

A resolution on a poll is carried if a majority of the creditors in value and number vote in favour of the resolution. The Chairperson advised that if a Poll is called, he would provide further information on how the process works and how a decision is reached.

### **RESOLUTIONS**

For the following resolutions, the Chairperson advised he would refer to the Remuneration Report dated 26 April 2017, attached as Appendix B to the Report to Creditors dated 3 May 2017:

# PBC current remuneration 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017

The Chairperson advised that, at the Second Meeting of Creditors held on 20 May 2016 pursuant to Section 439A of the Act, the Liquidators did not seek creditor approval of estimated future fees for the Liquidation of the Companies.

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' remuneration for the period 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 was proposed to the creditors of PBC:

"That the remuneration of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, for the period of the Liquidation from 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 is fixed at a sum equal to the additional cost of time spent by the Liquidators and the Liquidators' partners and staff, calculated at the hourly rates as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017 of fees equalling \$92,206.50 plus GST, and that the Liquidators can draw the remuneration as required."

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

## PBC future remuneration 15 April 2017 to completion

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' future remuneration for the period 15 April 2017 to completion of the Liquidation was proposed to the creditors of PBC:

"That the prospective remuneration of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, calculated at the hourly rates as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017, for the period from 15 April 2017 to finalisation, is fixed and approved to a maximum cap of \$79,985.00 plus GST, to be drawn only when incurred. Should a lesser amount be actually incurred; only the lesser amount will be drawn. Should a greater amount be actually incurred, further approval from the creditors of the company will be sought"

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

# PBC current disbursements 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' disbursements for the period 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 was proposed to the creditors of PBC:

"That the disbursements of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, for the period of the Liquidation from 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017, are approved in the sum of \$3,527.38 plus GST."

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

# ASDS current remuneration 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017

The Chairperson advised that, at the Second Meeting of Creditors held on 20 May 2016 pursuant to Section 439A of the Act, the Liquidators did not seek creditor approval of estimated future fees for the Liquidation of the Companies.

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' remuneration for the period 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 was proposed to the creditors of ASDS:

"That the remuneration of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, for the period of the Liquidation from 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 is fixed at a sum equal to the additional cost of time spent by the Liquidators and the Liquidators' partners and staff, calculated at the hourly rates as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017 of fees equalling \$76,609.50 plus GST, and that the Liquidators can draw the remuneration as required."

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

# **ASDS future remuneration 15 April 2017 to completion**

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' future remuneration for the period 15 April 2017 to completion of the Liquidation was proposed to the creditors of PBC:

"That the prospective remuneration of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, calculated at the hourly rates as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017, for the period from 15 April 2017 to finalisation, is fixed and approved to a maximum cap of \$70,537.50 plus GST and disbursements, to be drawn only when incurred. Should a lesser amount be actually incurred, only the lesser amount will be drawn. Should a greater amount be actually incurred, further approval from the creditors of the company will be sought"

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

## ASDS current disbursements 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017

The following resolution in relation to the Liquidators' disbursements for the period 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 was proposed to the creditors of ASDS:

"That the disbursements of the Liquidators, their partners and staff, for the period of the Liquidation from 21 May 2016 to 14 April 2017 as detailed in the Remuneration Report of 26 April 2017, are approved in the sum of **\$2,901.25 plus GST."** 

The Chairperson asked that all in favour of the resolution say aye and all those against say nay.

The Chairperson declared the resolution carried unanimously.

## **CLOSURE OF MEETING**

The Chairperson thanked all for the attendance of the meeting. We will lodge copy of the minutes of today's meeting with ASIC as soon as they are available.

There being no further business, the Chairperson declared the meeting closed at 11:50 AM.
