1. Regulation : Permendag No 45 Tahun 2022

Date : 28 July 2022

Title : Penetapan Harga Patokan Ekspor Atas Produk Pertambangan Yang Dikenakan Bea

(Indonesian) Kelua

Title (English) : Determination of Export Benchmark Prices for Mining Products Subject to Export

Duties

Summary

This regulation determines the export benchmark prices by referring to the highest average price in international exchange, the highest average price of Free on Board (FOB), the highest average price applicable in the domestic market or the highest average price in importer country of mining products in the last month prior to the determination of export benchmark prices. The export benchmark price will be used as a foundation for determining export prices in exit duty calculation. The export benchmark prices in this regulation will be valid until new export benchmark prices are determined. The details regarding tariff of each product and its benchmark price will be disclosed in the appendix.

This regulation is in effect starting 1 August 2022.

2. Regulation : 193.K/MB.01/MEM.B/2022

Title (English) : Reference Price of Metal Minerals and Reference Price of Coal for August 2022

Summary

The Decree of the Minister of Energy and Resources number 193.K-MB.01-MEM.B-2022 establishes the reference price of metal minerals and reference price of coal for August 2022. The metal mineral commodities mentioned in this decision are nickel, cobalt, lead, zinc, aluminium, copper, forms of gold, forms of silver, forms of tin, manganese, iron ore, chrome ore, ilmenite concentrate, and titanium concentrate. There are different reference prices for each commodity as seen in the appendix of the decision. The reference price for coal is 321,59 USD/ton.

This regulation is in effect starting 5 August 2022.

Title (English) : Reference Price of Metal Minerals and Reference Price of Coal for July 2022

Summary

The Decree of the Minister of Energy and Resources number 170.K-MB.01-MEM.B-2022 establishes the reference price of metal minerals and reference price of coal for July 2022. The metal mineral commodities mentioned in this decision are nickel, cobalt, lead, zinc, aluminium, copper, forms of gold, forms of silver, forms of tin, manganese, iron ore, chrome ore, ilmenite concentrate, and titanium concentrate. There are different reference prices for each commodity as seen in the appendix of the decision. The reference price for coal is 319,00 USD/ton.

This regulation is in effect starting 7 July 2022.

Title (English) : Guidelines for the Implementation of Presidential Regulation Number 55 of 2022

concerning Delegation of the Granting of Business Licenses in the Mineral and Coal

Mining Sector

Summary

In this guideline for implementing the Presidential Regulation Number 55 of 2022 concerning Delegation of Granting Business Licenses in the Mineral and Coal Mining Sector, there are several provisions that include: directions regarding the authority of the central government in managing mineral and coal mining that is transferred to the provincial government; the granting of business permit regulations; the provisions regarding maintaining continuity of requests and applications submitted before the Presidential Regulation Number 55 of 2022 is in effect on 11 April 2022; cooperation between provincial government and central government regarding authorization of business permit in mining sector; the provincial government is obligated to submit registration cover letter of mining business permit to the Minerba One Data Indonesia system; lastly, the authorization of mining business permit must be compliance to the feasible standard, procedure, and criteria or to the regulations issued by the central government.

This regulation is in effect starting 29 June 2022.



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
