



泰国入境新规定

2025 年 5 月 1 日起启用泰国电子入境卡
(TDAC) 规定：所有非泰籍人士须入境
前 3 天内完成在线申报

自 2025 年 5 月 1 日起，泰国政府将实施一项新的入境管理要求。届时，所有非泰国籍人士无论通过航空、陆路或海运方式入境泰国，均须在抵达前在线填写“泰国电子入境卡”（Thailand Digital Arrival Card，简称 TDAC）。TDAC 是泰国政府新推出的一项数字化平台，旨在优化入境流程、提升边境管控效率。目前该系统已开放使用，自 2025 年 5 月 1 日起将正式成为强制性要求。

所有外国旅客必须在抵达日期前三天内（包括抵达当日）完成 TDAC 在线登记。登记内容包括个人基本信息、护照资料、行程安排以及在泰国的住宿地址等。该系统将全面取代目前入境时所填写的纸质 TM.6 入境卡。

新规定的关键信息：

- **实施日期:** 2025 年 5 月 1 日
- **适用人群:** 所有非泰国籍入境人士
- **提交方式:** 通过 [TDAC Portal](#) 官方网站在线提交
- **提交时限:** 在抵达泰国前三天内完成（含抵达当日）
- **实施目的:** 推动移民服务现代化，提升入境通关效率

提交电子入境卡所需填写的主要信息：

- 护照信息
- 个人基本资料
- 旅游行程安排
- 在泰期间住宿地址
- 健康申报信息

德勤建议

建议所有非泰国籍旅客（包括游客、商务访客、外籍工作人士、永久居民签证持有人及长期居留签证持有人等）务必在出发前提前完成电子入境卡在线登记，以确保顺利入境。若未事先完成该登记，可能导致入境延误，甚至面临入境受阻的风险。
