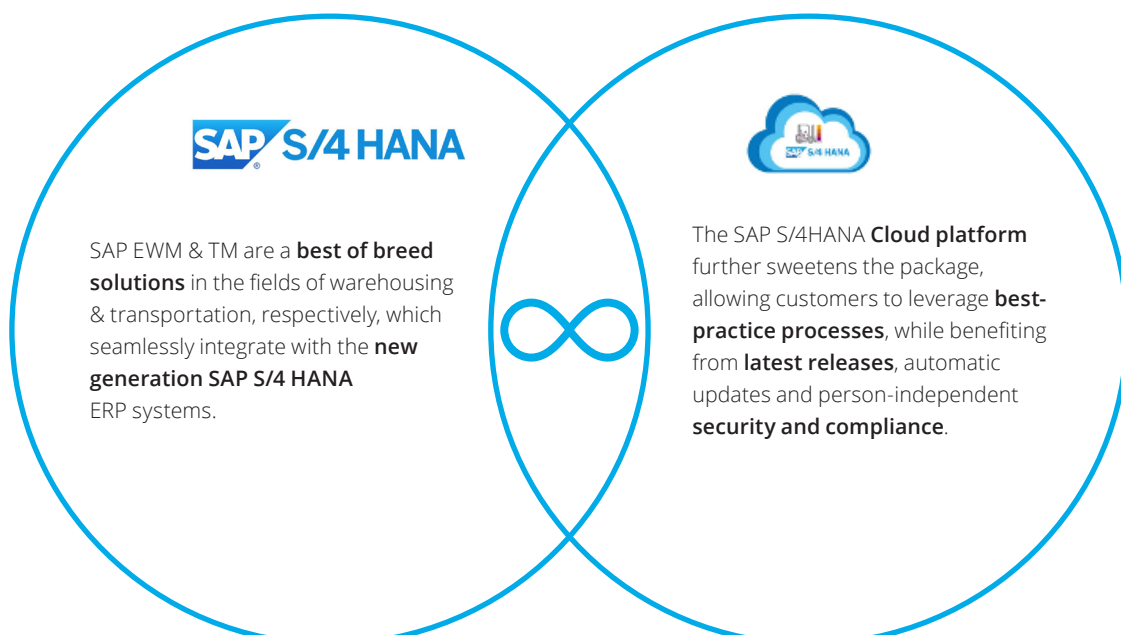

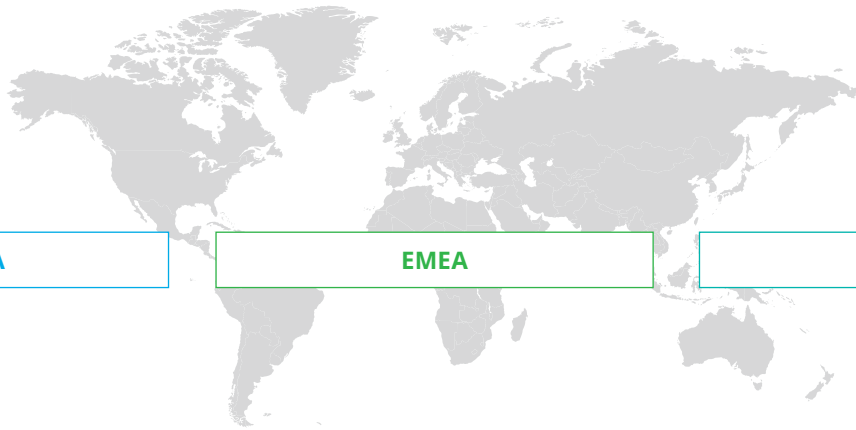
AUGMENTED & VIRTUAL REALITY
