

New law on partial wage tax exemptions applies as from 1 April 2022

The law on the reduction of labour costs as part of the "mini tax shift" was adopted on 28 March 2022 and published in Belgium's official journal on 31 March 2022 (<u>Dutch</u> | <u>French</u>).

This law brings substantial changes to the wage tax exemption for shift and night work, tightening up the eligibility requirements and introducing new formalities. Some of the provisions of the new law enter into force as from 1 April 2022. Please see our previous tax alerts of 14 March 2022 and 25 February 2022 for commentary on the key changes introduced by the legislation.
