Extension to the deadline for the submission of 2023 Personal Income Tax returns (TD1s)

We would like to inform you that a <u>Decree</u> (No.209/2024) was published on Friday 21 June 2024 in the Official Gazette, which extends the deadline for the electronic submission of the 2023 Personal Income Tax returns (TD1s) for employees, pensioners and self-employed persons who do not prepare audited financial statements until 31 October 2024.

The deadline for the payment of the final tax due through self-assessment for the tax year 2023 is also extended until 31 October 2024.

It is noted that the obligation to submit a personal income tax return for tax year 2023 falls on employees, pensioners and self-employed persons without audited financial statements, whose gross total income for the tax year 2023 exceeds the amount of €19,500.
