Simone Bemporad is Group Chief Communications & Public Affairs Officer for Assicurazioni Generali and member of the Group Management Committee (GMC). He is Deputy Chair of The Human Safety Net (THSN) the Foundation for the support of the disadvantaged communities in 23 countries in the world where Generali works.

THSN has worked with over 60 NGOs, providing assistance to over 130,000 children aged between 0 and 6 and their parents in difficult circumstances, delivering substantial support in parenting skills. In the same period, THSN has contributed to the creation of nearly 300 micro-enterprises across Europe.

As a founder of THSN, Bemporad also initiated the project to restore the Procuratie Vecchie complex in St. Mark's Square, Venice. The historic Generali building, in a state of semi-abandonment since the 1980s, is now open to the public for the first time in 500 years, following a 5-year recovery under the guidance of the architect Sir David Chipperfield.

In his role in Generali, Bemporad has driven the implementation of sustainability policies at Group level. As a result of this approach, the new 2022-2024 strategic plan placed sustainability as the "originator" of Assicurazioni Generali's strategy.

He has published a number of books and has been featured in interviews. Recently, Marsilio Editori published a conversation that he held with Renata Codello, Secretary General of the Cini Foundation (Imprese Private e Pubbliche Virtù, 2022, preface by Romano Prodi).

As Director and Chief Artistic Officer of the Solomon R. Guggenheim Foundation, Thomas Krens was responsible for the operation and programming of the seven museums in the Guggenheim global network: the Solomon R. Guggenheim Museum and the Guggenheim Museum Soho in New York; Guggenheim Museum Bilbao in Spain; the Peggy Guggenheim Collection in Venice, Italy; the Deutsche Guggenheim Berlin; the Guggenheim Hermitage Museum in Las Vegas; and the Guggenheim Las Vegas.

During his twenty-year tenure at the Guggenheim, Mr. Krens produced 292 exhibitions for the Guggenheim Museum network, including the career retrospectives of Robert Rauschenberg, Roy Lichtenstein, Anselm Kiefer, Mathew Barney, Jenny Holzer, Ellsworth Kelly, Francesco Clemente, Mario Merz, Anselm Kiefer, Andy Warhol, Georg Baselitz, Nam Jun Paik, Robert Morris, Zaha Hadid, Giorgio Armani and Frank Gehry among others.

Mr. Krens was in charge of designing and implementing the Guggenheim Abu Dhabi Museum project on behalf of the Guggenheim Foundation.

Mr. Krens founded Global Cultural Asset Management (GCAM1 LLC) in 2008, a company that pursues a cluster of overlapping businesses related to the expansion of art, culture, and art museums, primarily in Asia and the Middle East.

Mr. Krens has been awarded The Order of the Aztec Eagle, bestowed by the Government of Mexico (2005), Lifetime Achievement Award, Americans for the Arts (2003), Golden Lion Prize for Architectural Patronage at the Venice Architecture Biennale (2000), as well as Honorary Degrees from Yale University, Williams College, and the State University of New York at Albany.



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
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
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
