

I am excited to welcome you to the third edition of the Deloitte Technology Fast 50 program which is a showcase of the fastest growing technology companies in the Middle East and Cyprus. I am really pleased to see that this has become a well-recognized program across the region, with applications growing every year and new entrants in the list.

The country has established itself as a regional leader in this field, with abundant funding and investment. Cyprus also has a growing economy supporting start-ups in various tech sectors, with a focus on attracting investors and entrepreneurs

through initiatives like tax incentives and funding opportunities. The government and private sector are working together to establish the island as a top destination for tech talent, building on its tangible and intangible infrastructure whilst supporting accelerators, incubators, research institutions and the emerging VC space.





Technology Fast 50

This category recognizes high-growth companies with technological advancements that were founded before 1 January 2019 and their annual revenue was at least \$50,000 in 2019 and \$250,000 in 2022.

Rising Star

This category recognizes companies that are growing rapidly with the potential to be future Fast 50 candidates.

Companies of this category were founded after 1 January 2019 and their annual revenue over the last twelve months, must be at least \$50,000.

Women in Leadership

This category recognizes companies that meet all the main Fast 50 program criteria and are either led by a female* CEO or have a founding team comprised of at least 50% women.

Impact

This category recognizes companies that have an Environmental, Social, and Governance (ESG) element at the heart of their mission.




- To assess opportunities that fit the investment strategy;

DTA is a driving force for Qatar's digital economy, investing in early-stage technology companies, facilitating connections between investors and startups, fostering entrepreneurship, and serving as a thought-leader in technology, investments and startups.

The Saudi UK Tech Hub was launched by the Saudi British Joint Business Council (SBJBC) in London on 26 May 2022 in the presence of HE Majed al Qasabi, Minister of Commerce and HRH Prince Khalid bin Bandar al Saud, Saudi Ambassador to the UK.

The Tech Hub serves as a platform to connect and promote the Saudi and UK tech ecosystems. It is a response to the increasing prominence of entrepreneurship and tech within the Saudi Vision 2030 agenda and the opportunity to leverage UK expertise and innovation to help the Kingdom achieve its goals and create mutually beneficial partnerships.

Since we launched the Tech Hub, Saudi Arabia has risen rapidly to become the largest MENA nation in terms of venture capital investment. The Kingdom has a domestic market and a business environment is opening up.

Over the last year SBJBC has organised several high-profile initiatives to enhance tech sector collaboration between our countries.

Our Cleantech Venture Day in London in March 2023 brought together over 200 public and private sector leaders in cleantech. The event featured panel sessions followed by pitches from UK and Saudi startups. The UK winner was Poweroll, and the Saudi winner was Uvera.

We then led a delegation of Saudi cleantech companies and government stakeholders to Newcastle, where we heard about current and future collaboration with the Northeast of England.

In May 2023, we hosted a panel session at Innovation Zero, London's foremost event focussed on the role of tech within the green transition. Companies represented included SABIC, Al Fanar, SRMG Think, Octopus Ventures, and Connected Places Catapult.


SBJBC's annual flagship event at Mansion House in the City of London in June 2023 coincided with the halfway point of Saudi Arabia's Vision 2030 programme and focussed on mutual partnership and investment opportunities between our two Kingdoms. We hosted over 100 Saudis stakeholders and the tech sector was heavily represented within this.

We also hosted a roundtable at the event on "Technology Innovation and Developing the Digital Economy" including fintech and E-commerce, building on recent successful events/initiatives. Those present included the Saudi Central Bank, Graphene Ventures, Bank SAB-Alawwal, Lean Technologies, and Fintech Saudi alongside leaders from the British tech community.

Most recently we built on the success of our first UK fintech mission by leading a delegation of over 30 fintech stakeholders including scaled companies, startups, and investors to Riyadh in January 2024.

This was one of the largest fintech delegations to visit the Middle East. It included a fintech venture day at the Garage Innovation District attended by over 150 fintech leaders and VC investors in the Kingdom. Following two panel sessions pitches were invited from UK and Saudi startups. The British winner was Zeal, and the Saudi winner was Siolla. The event was kindly co-sponsored by SAB-Alawwal Bank and Geidea and supported by the British Embassy in Riyadh, the Federation of Saudi Chambers, and the Ministry of Communications & IT.

Moving forward, we look forward to exploring new sectors such as healthtech and edtech, whilst building on progress achieved in fintech and cleantech. We look forward to working with long-term partners of the Tech Hub such as Deloitte to achieve this.
