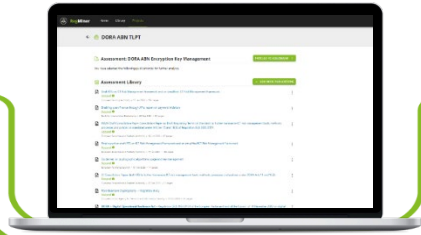

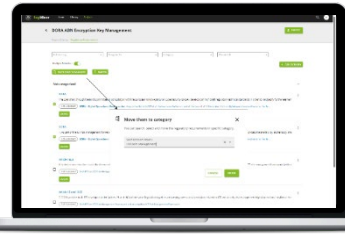

Assessment & Scoping

In the Assessment tool, where you would normally carry out all kinds of assessments, you collect the necessary publications and scope their relevant parts. RegMiner assists in mapping out the links between publications and suggests other potentially relevant documents, so you don't miss anything.

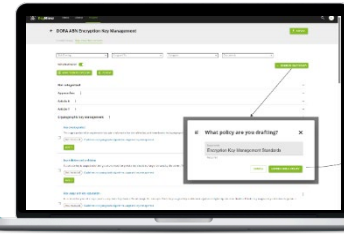

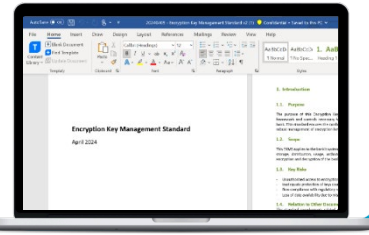

Generate Draft Policy Outline
