



General directorate of revenue launches tax lottery to prevent tax evasion



Resolution No. 1 of March 12, 2025, and Decree No. 26 of June 2, 2025 were recently published in the Official Gazette, announcing the launch of a Tax Raffle System based on Invoices, which will be presented to the public under the name of "Tax Lottery".

This initiative promoted by the General Directorate of Revenue in conjunction with the Gaming Control Board seeks to mitigate tax evasion by rewarding consumers by encouraging them to demand their tax invoices when making their purchases or receiving services in the country, thus creating a civic-tax culture of citizen oversight and promoting compliance with invoicing.

According to Decree No. 26 of June 2, 2025:

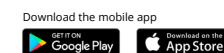
"What, this audit will result in a significant increase in the collections of Income Tax (ISR) and the Tax on the Transfer of Movable Tangible Property and the Provision of Service (ITBMS)."

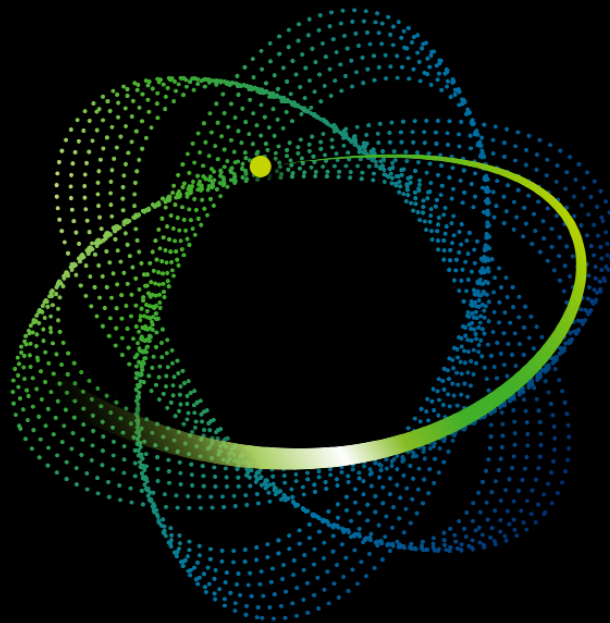
All individuals who deposit in the designated mailboxes, one or more duly sealed envelopes containing a minimum of five (5) tax invoices, electronic or equivalent, can participate in this dynamic. The envelopes must have on the outside: Full name of the sender, ID or passport number, physical address, email and telephone number.

It is important to consider that the invoices must not be more than 2 months old prior to the draw to be held. Invoices do not have a minimum amount to participate in the Tax Lottery.

The first draw of the Tax Lottery will be held on August 28, 2025, with a total of One Hundred and Ten Thousand Dollars (B/.110,000.00) in prizes distributed as follows: Five (5) prizes of Ten Thousand Dollars (B/.10,000.00); ten (10) prizes of Five Thousand Dollars (B/.5,000.00); and, ten (10) prizes of Mil Dollars (B/.1,000.00).
